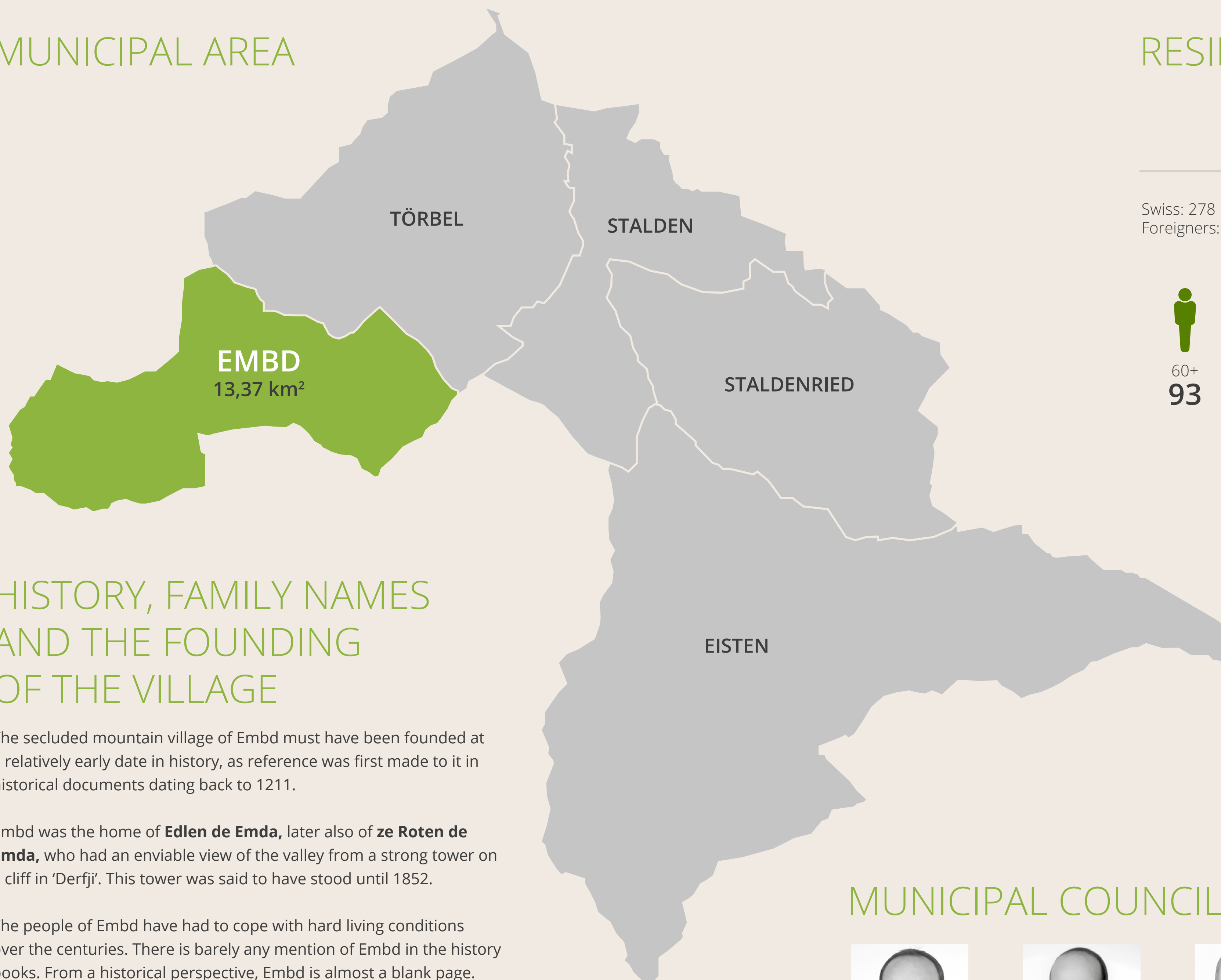

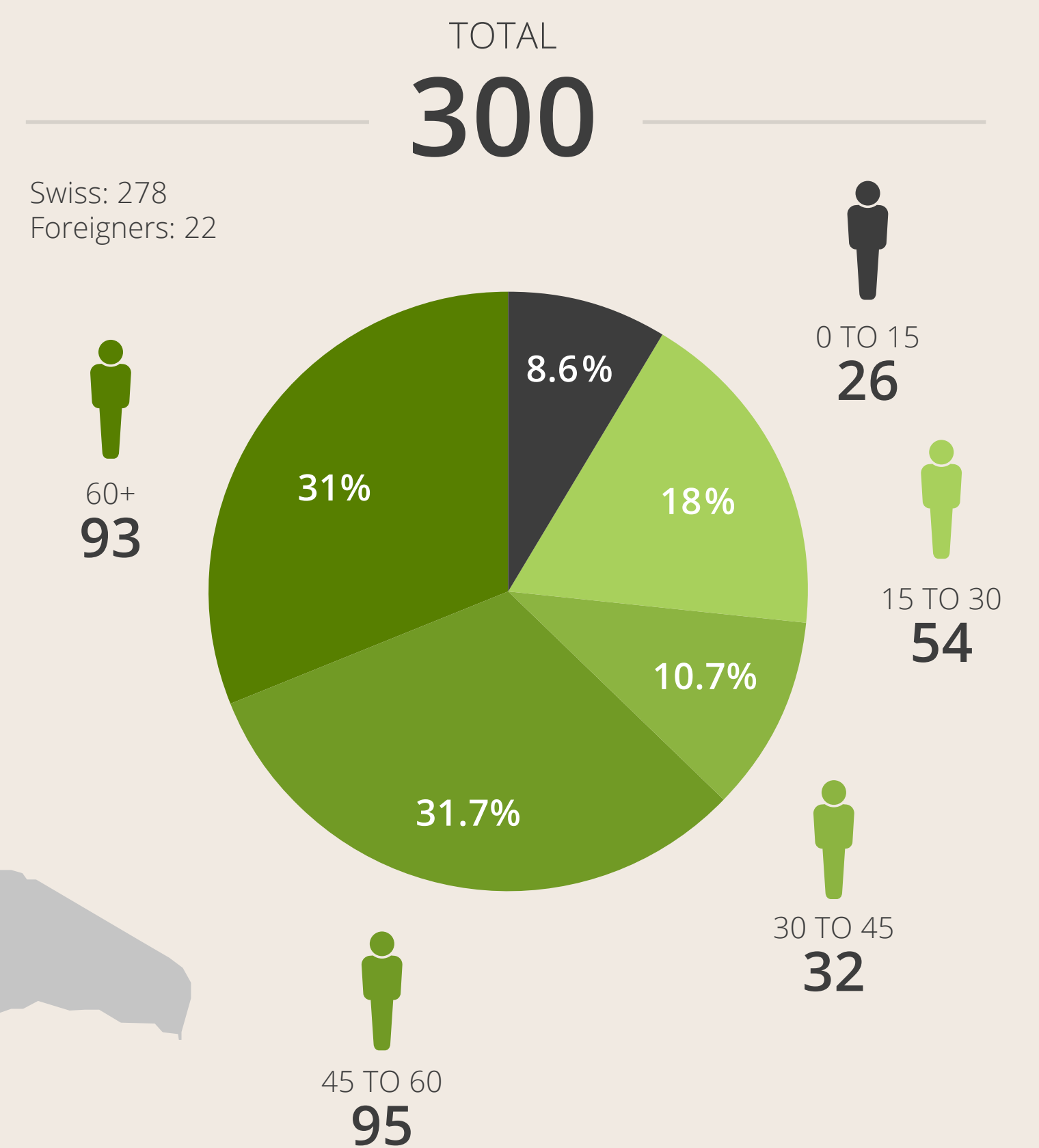
HISTORY, FAMILY NAMES AND THE FOUNDING OF THE VILLAGE

The secluded mountain village of Emdb must have been founded at a relatively early date in history, as reference was first made to it in historical documents dating back to 1211.

Emdb was the home of **Edlen de Emda**, later also of **ze Roten de Emda**, who had an enviable view of the valley from a strong tower on a cliff in 'Derfji'. This tower was said to have stood until 1852.

The people of Emdb have had to cope with hard living conditions over the centuries. There is barely any mention of Emdb in the history books. From a historical perspective, Emdb is almost a blank page.
