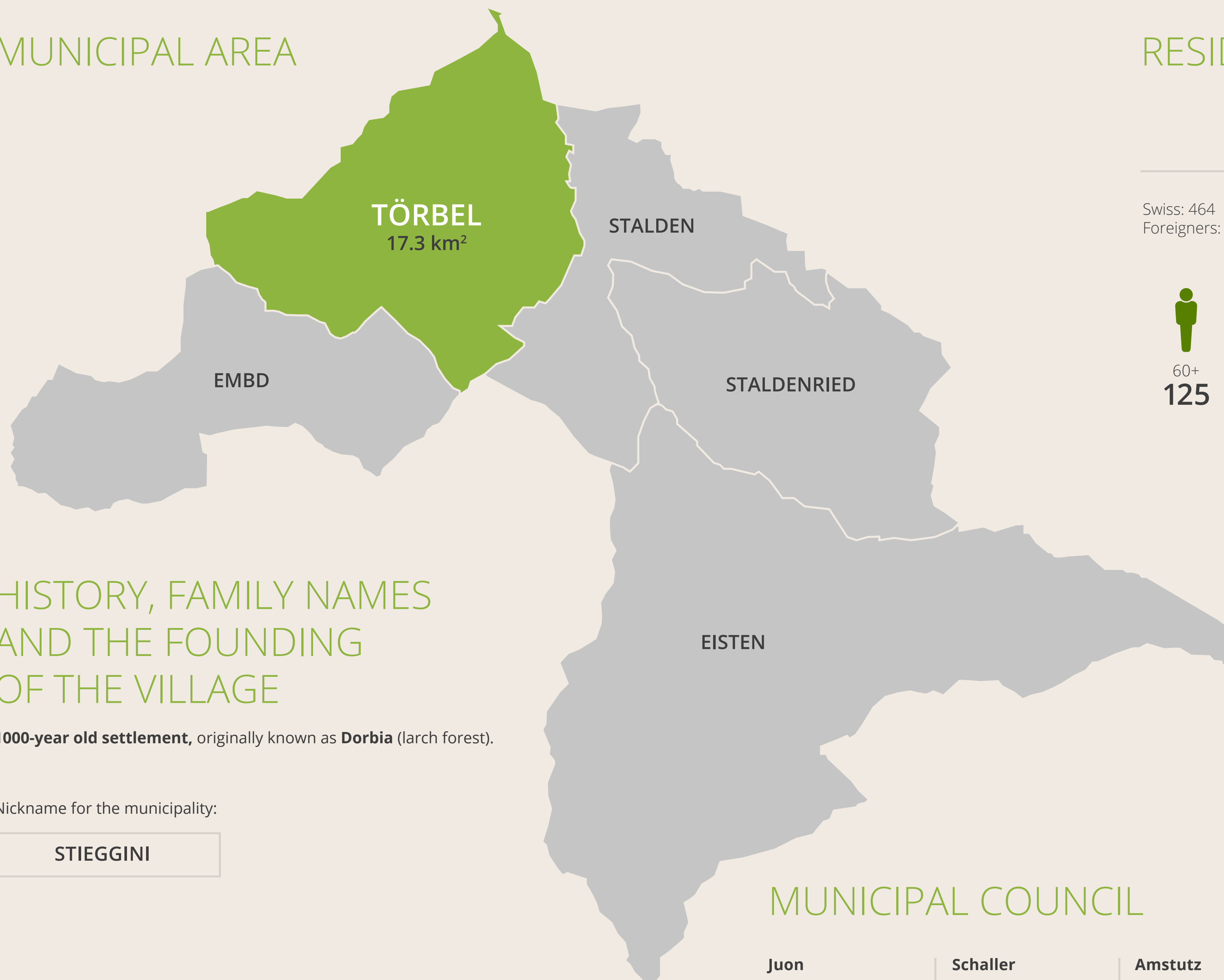

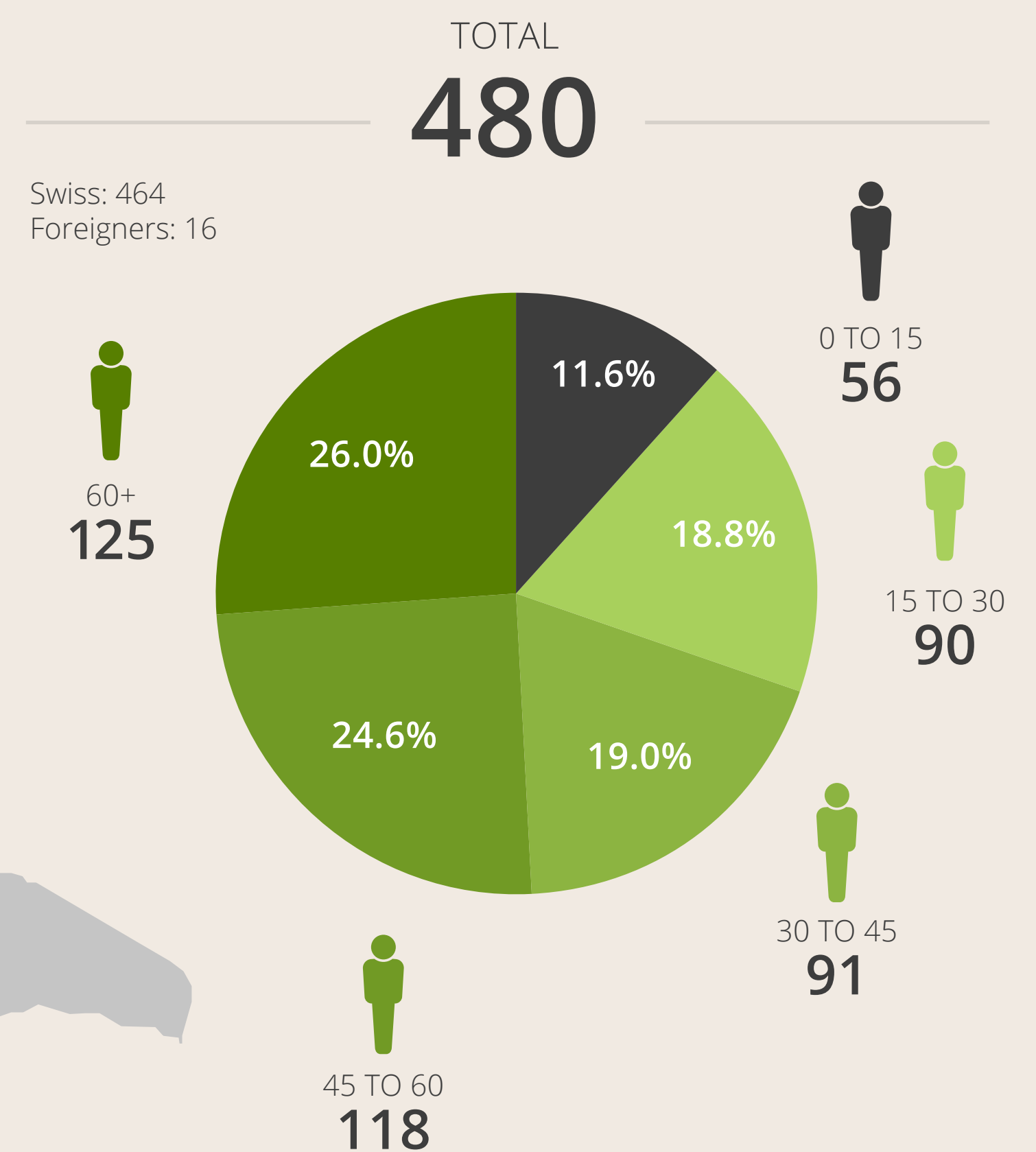
HISTORY, FAMILY NAMES AND THE FOUNDING OF THE VILLAGE

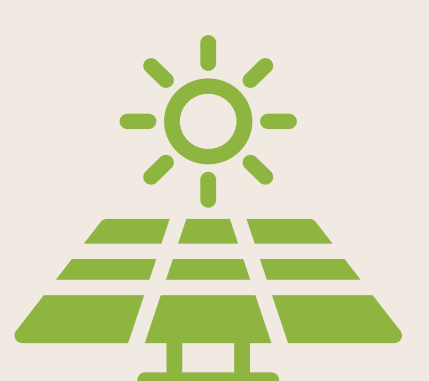
Being tough but welcoming
